



**VOTE #1 -- HR 889.** Fiscal 1995 Defense Supplemental Appropriations - Endangered Species Act. Baucus (D-MT), motion to table (kill) the Hutchison (R-TX) amendment to prohibit for the rest of fiscal 1995 the addition of new species to the endangered species list by rescinding \$1.5 million for the enforcement of the Endangered Species Act of 1973. Motion rejected 38-60: R 0-54; D 38-6 (ND 30-4, SD 8-2), March 16, 1995. (Subsequently, the Hutchison amendment was adopted by voice vote after a ruling of the chair that the amendment was non-germane was overruled. See next vote - #2). The League position was a "nay" vote.

**VOTE #2 -- HR 889.** Fiscal 1995 Defense Supplemental Appropriations - Decision of the Chair. Judgment of the Senate to affirm the ruling of the chair that the Hutchison (R-TX) amendment was non-germane. The Hutchison amendment would prohibit for the rest of fiscal 1995 the addition of new species to the endangered species list by rescinding \$1.5 million for the enforcement of the Endangered Species Act of 1973. Ruling of the chair rejected 42-57: R 0-54; D 42-3 (ND 33-2, SD 9-1), March 16, 1995. (Subsequently, the Hutchison amendment was adopted by voice vote). The League position was a "nay" vote to strike the ruling of the chair and support the Hutchison Amendment.

**VOTE #3 -- HR 1158.** Fiscal 1995 Emergency Supplemental Appropriations and Rescissions - Timber Harvesting. Gorton (R-WA) motion to table (kill) the Murray (D-WA) amendment to restore some of the environmental reviews that the bill sought to suspend in order to expedite timber harvesting. Motion agreed to 48-46: R 47-4; D 1-42 (ND 1-33, SD 0-9), March 30, 1995. The League position was a "yea" vote.

**VOTE #4 -- This is actually not a vote.** It gives credit to those Senators who are co-sponsoring **S-605**, the Omnibus Property Rights Act of 1995 introduced by Robert Dole (R-KS). S-605 is a bill to establish a uniform and more efficient federal process for protecting property owners' rights guaranteed by the fifth amendment. It would compensate private property owners faced with government "takings".
